**Postgraduate students admission in the “Program for Postgraduate Studies
with Specializations in Theoretical and Experimental Physics”**

In the framework of the Program of Postgraduate Studies of Physics, entitled "**Program of Postgraduate Studies of Physics with Specializations in Theoretical and Experimental Physics**", which operates in the Physics Department of the University of Ioannina (as reformed in Official Gazette no. 14220 / 17-5-2018), examinations will be conducted to select twenty (20) postgraduate students **in the first ten days of October 2018.**

The Program awards a Postgraduate Diploma as a "Diploma in Postgraduate Studies in Physics with Specialization in Theoretical Physics" or "Diploma in Postgraduate Studies in Physics with Specialization in Experimental Physics". Graduates of the Departments of School of Sciences (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Computer Science and Engineering, Materials Science and Biology), and related Departments of Polytechnic Schools in Greece or equivalent foreign institutions recognized from the Hellenic National Academic Recognition Center (NARIC) (according to law 3328/2005 (A '80)), graduates of Departments from Technological Educational Institutes (TEI) with relevant subjects as well as students who are planning to obtain a Bachelor degree until October 2018, are allowed to participate in the examinations.

The selection procedure is carried out under the responsibility of the Steering Committee (SC) of the Program of Postgraduate Studies and includes:

- A. Written examinations in General and Modern Physics.
 - B. Written examinations in a foreign language (English, French or German).
- Additionally, candidates are required to go through an oral interview with the SC.

Graduates of Physics Departments with a degree of at least seven (7/10) and a duration of studies of up to five (5) years, as well as holders of a Masters (MSc) degree in a subject related to the aforementioned postgraduate program, are exempted from the written examination in General and Modern Physics (however, it is required to participate in the written examination in a foreign language and in the oral interview).

Based upon their performance (a) in the Bachelor courses, and (b) in international tests as well as on the basis of recommendation letters, graduate students of foreign Universities can be admitted. The latter are required to go through an oral interview with the SC. The required level of language qualification for this category of candidates is C1 ("very good knowledge"). For the award of the Master's degree, the Bachelor qualification from the Hellenic NARIC must be necessarily recognized.

Candidates are invited to submit, by **14th of September 2018**, to the Secretariat of the Department of Physics an application for participation in the examinations accompanied by the following supporting documents:

- A short Curriculum Vitae
- A copy of Bachelor degree
- Transcript of records of undergraduate courses
- Any other element that, according to the candidates opinion, could assist in the selection procedure (e.g., diploma thesis, research experience, publications, recommendation letters, etc.).
